Seton Hall's 58-acre campus is located in the quaint town of South Orange, New Jersey, only 14 miles from Manhattan. The University is home to eight schools, over 60 majors and about 10,000 students. Founded: 1856 by Bishop James Roosevelt Bayley, affiliation: Catholic, oldest U.S. diocesan university, under the Archdiocese of Newark. While Seton Hall enjoys a big reputation, our campus community is also close-knit and inclusive. Students, faculty and staff come from around the world, bringing with them a kaleidoscope of experiences and perspectives, creating a diverse yet unified campus environment.

Cheney University

Founded in 1837 as the Institute for Colored Youth, Cheney University of Pennsylvania is the oldest of the Historically Black Colleges and Universities in America. The founding of Cheney University was made possible by Richard Humphreys, a Quaker philanthropist who bequeathed \$10,000, one tenth of his estate, to design and establish a school to educate the descendents of the African race. Today, Cheney University students represent a variety of races, cultures, and nationalities who receive education instruction beyond the vision of Richard Humphreys. Cheney graduates still become teachers, but students also enter careers such as journalism, medicine, business, science, law, communication, and government service. The university offers baccalaureate degrees in more than 30 disciplines and the master's degree in education.
